The St. Andrew Choir is the official liturgical choir of St. Andrew the Apostle School for 5th through 7th Grade students. The choir sings at all-school Masses, SuperFest, Open House, Grandparents' Day, Celebration in the Oaks, and our Spring Concert. We also sing at major parish liturgies (Christmas Eve, Holy Week services, and Easter).

It costs nothing to join. No prior experience is necessary. You do not need to know how to read music. There are no auditions. No one will ever be asked to sing alone unless they want to. We are looking for students who simply love to sing.

The Choir rehearses every Thursday afternoon from 3:15 to 4:15 in the Music Room, starting immediately. Guitarists and other instrumentalists will practice from 4:15 to 5:00 right after regular practice, starting immediately. **Students not picked up within 10 minutes after rehearsal will be sent to after school care.** To join, please have your parents fill out the registration form below and return it to School. Parents, please let me know if you can help out with 4:15 dismissal so the guitars can start without delay. All such parents must be certified in Safe Environment. **All announcements are made via Portal.**
