

When to stay at home...

Individual that Tests Positive for COVID-19

1. Individuals should stay home and notify school principal of positive result
2. The school will then follow the directive of the Regional Medical Director
3. Individuals may return after 10 days since onset of symptoms
 - Symptom free
 - 72 hours fever-free without medication

Individuals Exposed (Credible Exposure) to COVID-19 Case

1. Individuals should stay home for 14 days and contact his/her doctor
2. If positive, follow steps 1 for positive COVID 19 Test results

Individuals Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms (Fever, Persistent Cough, Trouble Breathing, ETC.)

1. Individuals should stay home and contact his/her doctor
2. An individual with fever > 100.4 F, may return once they have been fever free for 48 hours
 - We recommend that an individual who presents with a fever $\geq 100.4F$ or exhibits any other signs/symptoms of COVID-19 be evaluated by a healthcare professional to obtain a COVID-19 test if clinically indicated.
 - If an individual presents with a fever of $\geq 100.4F$ or exhibits any other signs/symptoms of COVID-19 and cannot be evaluated by a healthcare professional, they should remain home for 10 days

Individuals Being Tested or Awaiting COVID-19 Result

1. Individuals should stay home until results are received
2. If positive, follow steps 1 for positive COVID 19 Test results
3. Individuals may return if COVID-19 Test is negative.

Close contact is defined as a person who was within 6ft of an infected individual for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period starting from 2 days before illness onset until the time the patient is isolated.

All positive cases require notification of the school Principal

The school will work closely with the Department of Public Health and follow all directives of the Regional Medical Director.
